

## **BIDDING PROCEDURE FOR THE PAN AMERICAN MASTERS WEIGHTLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CANADIAN MASTERS WEIGHTLIFTING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

1. The CMWFHCM invites any interested registered weightlifting club to inquire about hosting a Pan American Weightlifting Championship.
2. The interested host club should be within 400 km of an International Airport.
3. The CMWFHCM provides the interested club with the proposed contractual expectations of the Pan American Weightlifting Federation by the CMWFHCM.
4. The interested weightlifting club approaches its Provincial Weightlifting Association for their preliminary support of their bid.
5. The Provincial Weightlifting Association and the weightlifting club jointly apply to the CWFHC and the CMWFHCM for their sanction/approval of their bid.
6. The CWFHC and the CMWFHCM must jointly approve/sanction the bid, with any amendments to the contractual expectations to the PAMWF.
7. The CMWFHCM submits the bid proposal to the PAMWF and the contractual expectations.
8. If the PAMWF agrees to the bid proposal and contractual obligations, the CWFHC and the CMWFHCM appoints up to two members each to represent their Federation with the club organizing committee.
9. The necessary documents are signed, copied and circulated to the Presidents of both Federations, the Provincial Weightlifting Association President and the Competition Director.
10. The rules and timelines outline in the PAWF guidelines are implemented and adhered to, with all signed documents provided to the Presidents of both Federations, the Provincial Weightlifting Association President and the Competition Director.
