

# International Team Awards

1. National Chair or designee accepts all Team Awards at the appropriate Awards Ceremony. The designee may be the most senior member of the Team present at the banquet.
2. National Chair or designee appoints a member of the winning team to be the first Guardian of the Award.
3. The Guardian of the award must be the most senior (longest membership status in CMWFHCM) athlete on the Team who is present at the banquet. If the Guardian who has attended the banquet is not the most senior athlete member of the Team, the trophy is passed to the most senior athlete member of the Team before the seventh month following the competition. If he/she is the most senior member athlete, he/she keeps the trophy until he/she is no longer a member of CMWFHCM, at which time the trophy passes to the next most senior athlete member. A Guardian must always be the most senior athlete member of the Team, who is still a member of CMWFHCM. The last Guardian keeps the trophy, whether or not he/she renews his/her membership.
4. The first Guardian(s) of the Award is responsible ensuring that Team members' names are inscribed. Cost of inscription and any mailing costs to other guardians are covered by the Federation.
5. Should any Guardian not renew his/her membership in the CMWFHCM, the National Chair will alert the President who will then arrange for a next Guardian. Postage costs will be covered by the CMWFHCM.
